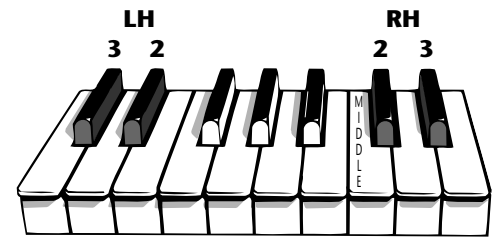

- 5 Play using RH & LH and say the finger numbers.
- 6 Play and sing the words.
