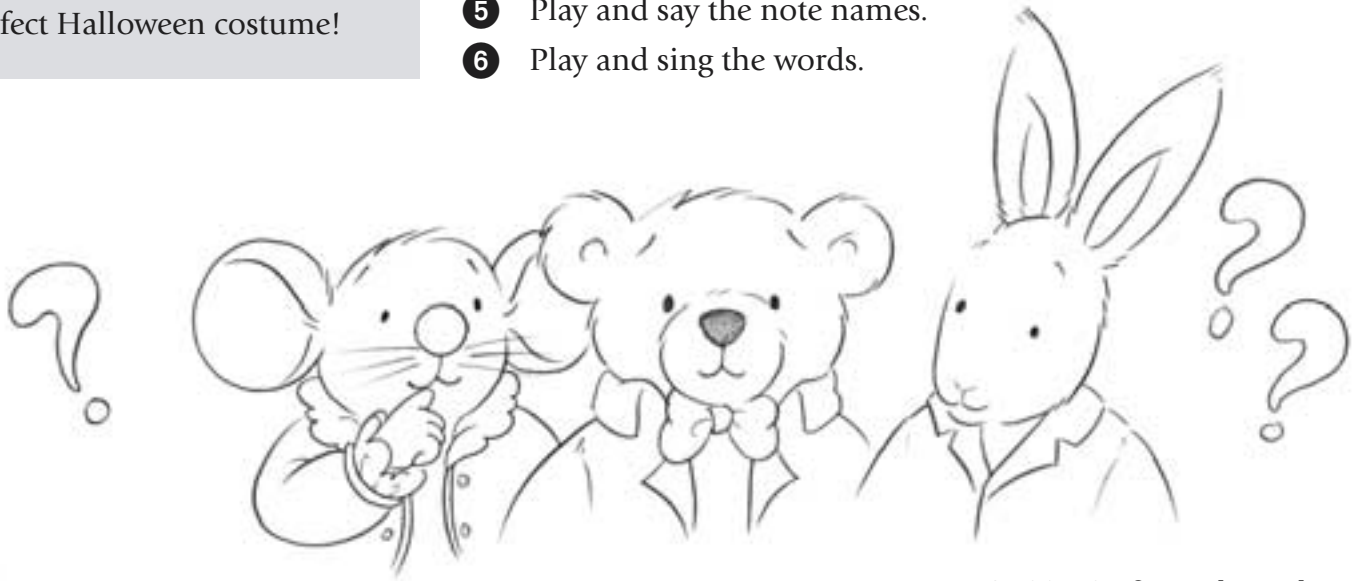


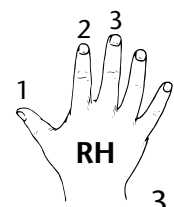
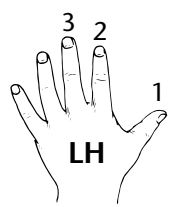
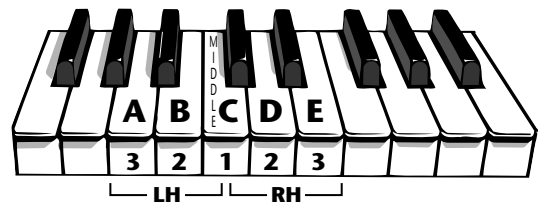
The three fell silent as they tried to think. Minutes passed, but no one had any ideas. Beethoven Bear began to think they would never find the perfect Halloween costume!
